Collection and Return

Trailer to be collected from and returned to ANZCO Foods Ltd, 5 Robin Mann Place, Christchurch Airport.

General

Dimensions: Height: 2400mm, Length: 4200mm, Width: 2000mm

Weight: 900kg braked trailer, please check your vehicle is capable of towing this weight

Travel Speed: Not to be towed in excess of 90 km

Cleaning: To be returned in the same clean state listed below, following return the trailer will be cleaned professionally to meet all Food Safety requirements. This does not mean you can return it uncleaned.

Terms of Use:

- Provide own gas bottle
- Any damage reported to ANZCO and repaired, or arrangements made for repair.
- Trailer to be used only for activities stated in the application form.
- Trailer must be returned by the agreed upon date and it must be returned in the same condition it was collected in. If not cleaned sufficiently there will be a \$75 cleaning fee applied.
 - Inside cleaned
 - Floor swept and mopped
 - All surfaces and walls cleaned down
 - Outside cleaned – free of dust and dirt
 - BBQ cleaned, including drip tray – free of any grease
 - All rubbish removed and fridge emptied and wiped down.

This will be checked upon return.

You will need to provide all your own cooking utensils. And it is recommended that you provide your own aprons, serviettes and cleaning cloths.



Insurance Policies:

Actions ANZCO Foods LTD cover:

- Normal use of the trailer, whether towing or used at site, resulting accidental damage to the trailer will be covered under our policies.
- ANZCO will be covered for damage caused to the trailer through misuse or a negligent/malicious act, however, our insurer is able to seek recovery of costs from the party the BBQ is loaned too.

Actions ANZCO Foods LTD does not cover:

- ANZCO will not take any responsibility for any damage caused to 3rd party property as a result of the use of the trailer, whether towing it, or using it at a site.
- ANZCO recommend that the loaner carries Public Liability Insurance as ANZCO cannot cover your liability.

In case of an accident please record the following details:

- Date, time and location
- Other parties name, cell phone number and vehicle registration
- Any witness contact details
- Photos

Prior to pick up:

- Check reverse lights are working on trailer
- Check indicator lights are working on trailer
- Check tyres are pumped up
- Check and note any scratches/dents
- Review and agree to instructions and policy documents
